Materials

- Scissors
- A stapler
- Glue

Instructions

Step 1

Carefully cut out your pages for your sketchbook by cutting around the dashed lines on the template.

Step 2

Place all your pages together in any order you choose. Fold your pages in half and staple in the middle.

Step 3

Place the cover page on the outside of your book so that it is facing out.


Step 4

There you have it! A spectacular sketchbook to fill with all the things you see and do!



Sketchbook Cover



