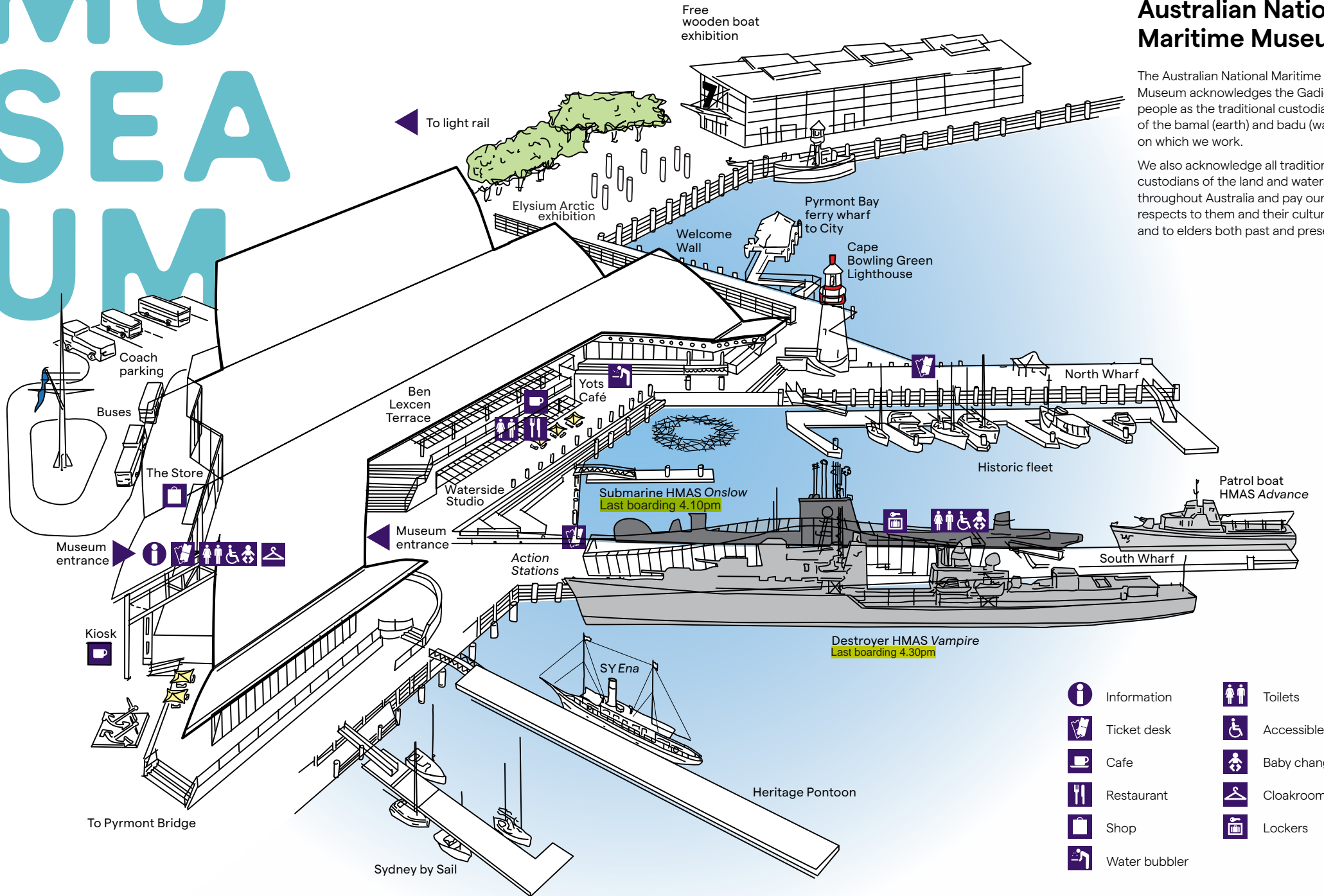

Welcome to the Australian National Maritime Museum

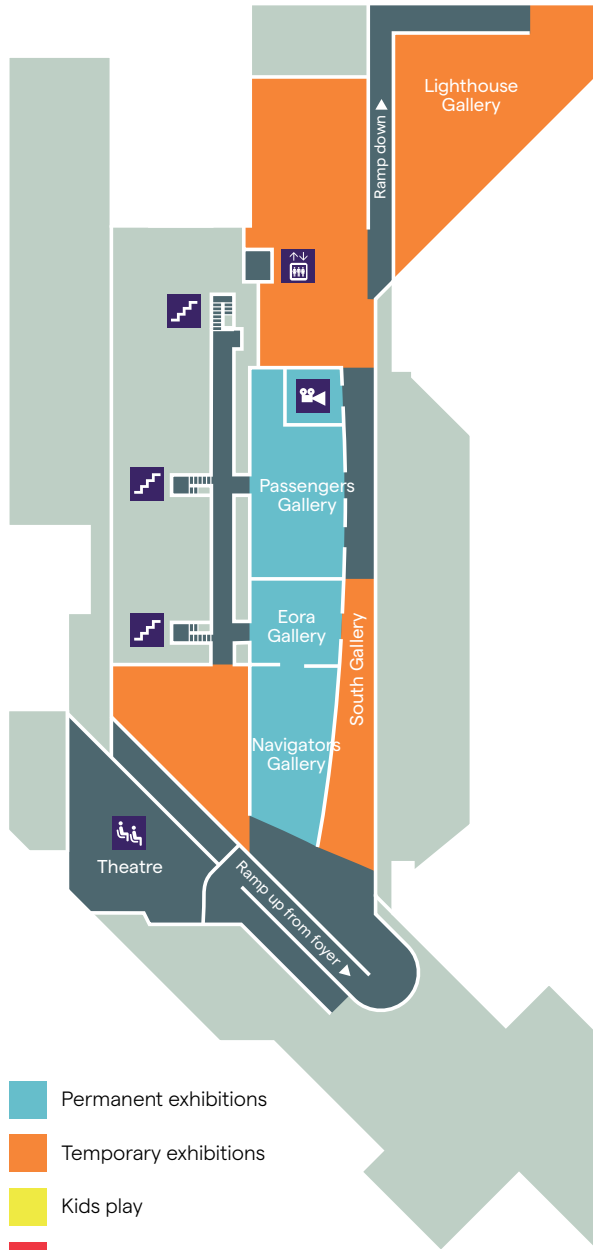
The Australian National Maritime Museum acknowledges the Gadigal people as the traditional custodians of the bamal (earth) and badu (waters) on which we work.

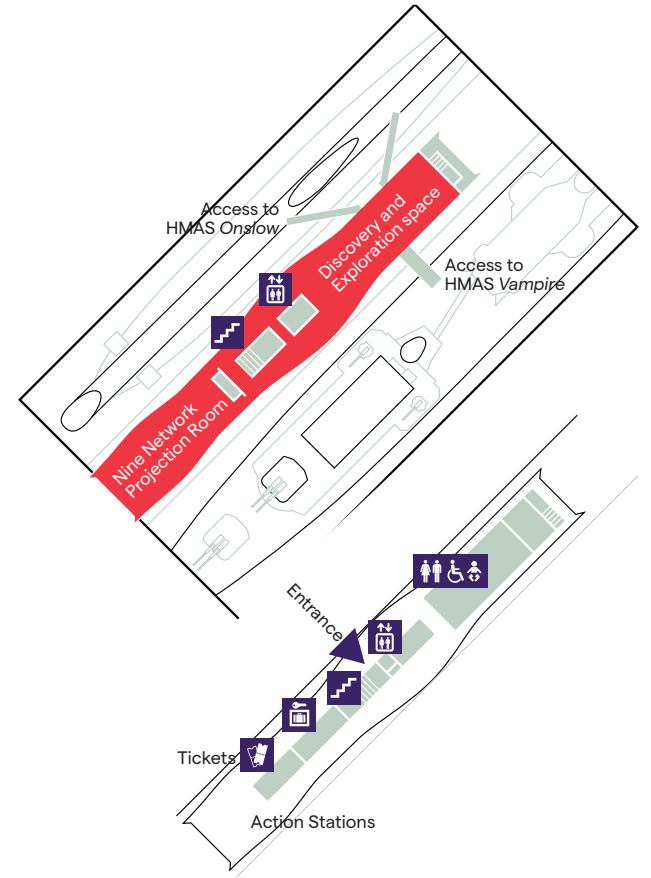
